WIND BAND

Arrangements for Sat 25th April

- **‘Music in the Forces’ careers presentation @12.30pm in the ante-room @ The Coro. Please try to attend – as many people as possible (massed band players MUST attend), this is what pays for their visit from the government’s point of view!**

For the concert:

- Arrive at The Coro between 6.50pm and 7.15pm at the latest (audience cannot get in before 6.40pm). Full band uniform – pink shirt/black trousers/skirt/black shoes & socks.
- Instrument cases in the ant-room (just off the foyer). You are NOT allowed downstairs into the dressing rooms, we can only use the ante-room!
- Set up pad/stand etc on stage

Provisional timings for the concert

9.00pm	Massed Band finale (players know who they are)
9.35pm	Finish

- Once we have finished the set we must quickly take our instruments and pads off stage and back into the ante-room. Massed Band players must keep hold of their instruments, everyone else pack them away and leave in the ante-room.
- For the second part of the concert, we are standing/sitting in the aisles (**quietly**) to watch – massed band players keep instruments with them. Also, watch out for the drummers marching in and out, you will need to stand by the walls to let them march past or they will kick you!!!!
- After 2nd part, massed band players quickly get sorted on stage. Remainder stay in the aisles to watch **quietly**.
